- 2 (white) Hi-polymer erasers (not the pink pearl type)
- hand sanitizer (we have plenty already)
- 1 Composition Book (spiral bound)

Items Needed Most:

Community Supplies (please do not label)

- 3 boxes of Kleenex tissue
- 2 containers of cleaning wipes (NO Clorox Bleach containing sodium hypochlorite)
- 2 packages of white copy paper
- 2 pkg. of #2 Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (NO mechanical or decorative pencils)

Personal Supplies (please label)

- 1 box of Crayola 24 count crayons (do not need 2 boxes)
- 1 box of Crayola 12 count-colored pencils (full length)
